## Why this exists.

Todd was not my father by blood, but he became the only father I ever really knew. He married my mother as a 22-year-old, stepping into a ready-made family and a role he'd never seen modeled for him, and did the best he knew how. Our home life was often complicated and volatile, and over the years my parents separated and reunited more than once before finally parting ways. In that process many people drifted away from Todd, but for me his impact never did.

Todd was a gifted carpenter and craftsman who poured himself into wood and metal — furniture, homes, countless projects built with his hands. I owe much of my own skill in woodworking and auto mechanics to quietly watching him work. We didn't share many heart-to-heart talks or picture-perfect father-son moments, but I learned from how he moved through the world: how he tackled problems, how he made something solid and useful out of raw material.

His own childhood left deep marks, and in later years life became harder for him. Many of us lost touch. Yet the influence he had on who I became remained permanent. Todd was imperfect and complex, but he was also the man whose life and work helped shape mine — and for that I will always be grateful.
